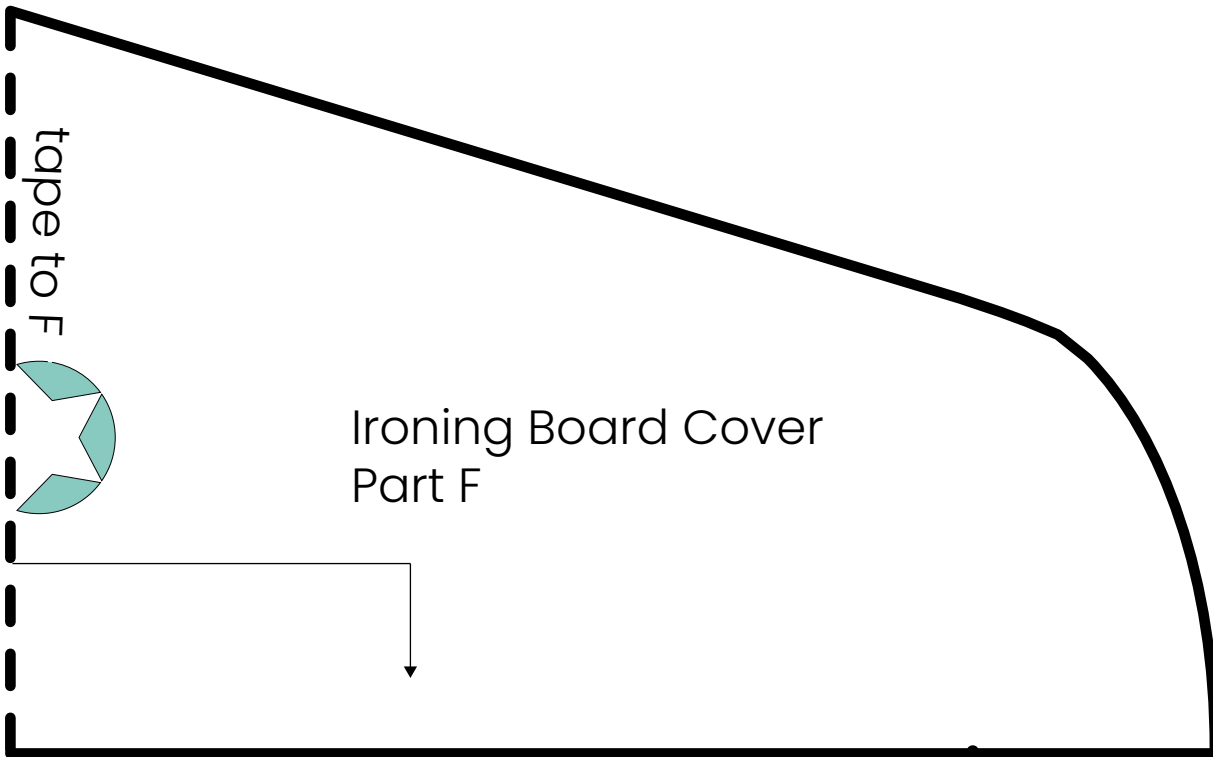

## Elizabeth Made This Ironing Board Cover Pattern

Printing instructions: Print out this pattern at 100% (no scaling) on 8.5"x11" paper.

Assembling your pattern: The Ironing board Cover consists of all of the pieces.

Match pieces and tape along indicated lines, matching up the stars along the black dotted lines.

Before you cut this pattern out, use a ruler to add 2" around the side and curved edge (not the edge on the fold).

Cut 1 Ironing Board cover (All pieces taped) on the fold from your fabric.

Cut 1 Ironing board insulation from insulated batting following the inner blue curve on the pattern.

Also cut 2 strips of fabric 4.5" wide x 71" long .
